Treehouse Enrichments Tutoring

Tutoring Procedures

Initial Session:

The initial tutoring helps develop a working relationship between myself and the student. It is a time to discuss our tutoring goals, how the student will work best in this tutoring environment, and what is expected of each other to produce the greatest results.

In this session, the student's adults may choose to participate so that we can all get off to a good start.

Session Lengths:

Except when arranged in advance, tutoring sessions run 50 minutes.

Before Each Session:

On the day of tutoring, students receive an email reminding them of their session. Included with this email is the Zoom link to their session, the link to their online folder, and any information needed to get them ready for tutoring.

Typical Session Agenda:

Tutoring sessions typically begin with an informal check-in: how the student's day is going, what they've been up to, and so forth. This discussion is brought around to asking about the student's current writing workload, their school work, and assignments from our previous sessions.

Students may be personally involved for up to 30 minutes during a session writing, researching, editing, or other tasks.



When time permits, breaks in tutoring allow the student to recharge by doing some quick exercises, ad-hoc storytelling, and other activities to help their thinking stay sharp.

At the end of the session is a check-out to recap what has been covered and discuss tasks assigned for the next session.

Writing Assignments:

Most tutoring ends with the student having a writing assignment on which they will need to work before the next session. These can involve a writing task from one of the student's classes, an assignment related to the subject matter we are covering together, or both. Assignments are not expected to take longer than 45 minutes to complete.

Student Technology:

All tutoring is accomplished one-on-one using the secure Zoom meeting platform. Additionally, each student will have a dedicated folder on the Treehouse Enrichment Google Drive and will be able to post material and read content whenever they like.

We will use Google Docs during tutoring as our writing tool. Google Docs is easy to use and many students are already experienced with it in the classroom. The ability to easily share documents and work collaboratively in real-time makes it ideal for tutoring activities.

Students, of course, will need a computer, laptop, or tablet with a webcam, microphone, keyboard (and mouse, if possible), and an Internet connection. Access to a printer is also highly recommended.



Post-Tutoring:

After each tutoring session, the student receives an email summarizing what we covered and the work assigned for next time. As desired, this email can be sent to the student alone, or with a copy “CC-ed” to the student’s adult.

Payment:

Tutoring fees are \$75.00 per session with payment requested on each day of service. Payments may be sent through either Zelle or Venmo. Fee and payment information may always be discussed before tutoring begins.
